



The Bob Beaman Memorial 'B-Involved' Scholarship

The Bob Beaman 'B-Involved' Scholarship has been established in honor of Bob's memory to recognize young adults who are conscious of and committed to their communities. A life-long resident of Madison, Bob never waived in his support of his home town. Over the course of his lifetime, Bob was an active member of groups like the Madison Environmental Commission where he helped create the Adopt-a-Park Program, Environmental Recycling and the Anti-Idling efforts in town. He was a Little League coach and BSA Scout and Venturing leader for more than 37 years. As a mentor and advisor, Bob believed the local youth and young adults to be intelligent, caring and capable leaders of the future. The 'B-Involved' Scholarship provides a \$1000 stipend to a young adult who has a demonstrated history of community service and volunteerism.

Eligibility

1. Graduating high school students through completion of a secondary education [college/university/technical school] with at least a 2.5 GPA
2. Students who have lived, worked, attended school and/or been involved as a participant/volunteer in a Madison or Chatham based community program or as an Attendee, Alumni or Staff of the LEDR Program.
3. Students who are or have been affiliated with a Scouting program (Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Venture, LEDR)

Selection

Awards will be based on the record of your community involvement, the quality of your essay, and other personal achievements. Semi-finalists may be personally interviewed prior to selection of the award recipient(s).

Award

The Bob Beaman 'B-Involved' Scholarship provides an annual scholarship of \$1,000. At its discretion, the committee may award one or two scholarships per year.

Application Process

Along with the application, please submit:

1. A brief essay [500-1000 words] describing your personal motivation and achievements in regards to community consciousness, integrity, and respect for those less fortunate. We want to know why you do what you do for your community.

Applications, essays and reference/recommendation letters must be post-marked by October 31, 2015. Questions may be directed to www.tef-ledr.org. The 'B-Involved' Scholarship recipients will be announced on Black Friday, the day after Thanksgiving.
